Copy Position Chart

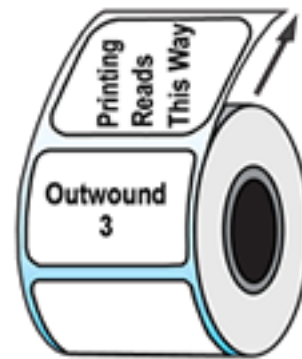
After completion of printing and die-cutting, the converted label roll is taken from the printing press to the rewind department for finishing. In this department, the labels receive a final quality inspection where any labels that do not meet quality standards are removed. Electronic counters aid in rewinding the rolls to 1,000, 500, 250, etc... or whatever count is ordered.



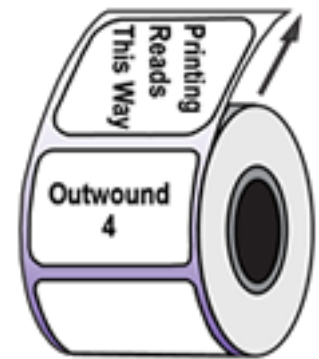
1. Copy printed across the roll. Top of label comes off first.



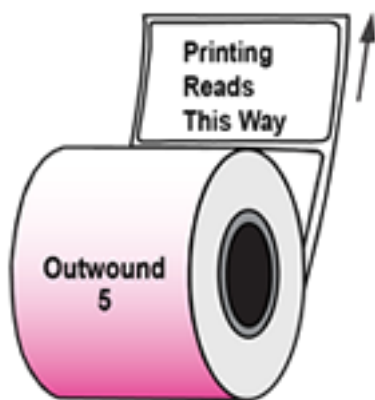
2. Copy printed across the roll. Bottom of label comes off first.



3. Copy printed around the roll. Right side of label comes off first.



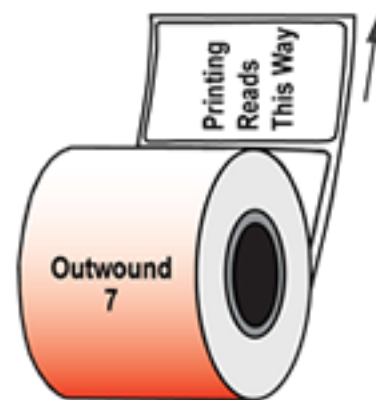
4. Copy printed around the roll. Left side of label comes off first.



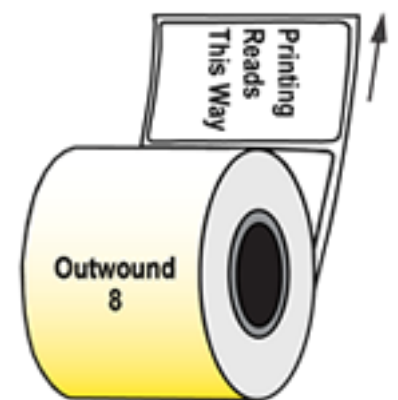
5. Copy printed across the roll. Top of label comes off first.



6. Copy printed across the roll. Bottom of label comes off first.



7. Copy printed around the roll. Right side of label comes off first.



8. Copy printed around the roll. Left side of label comes off first.
